The scoring and decision process takes approximately four weeks after the deadline. Twin Cities applicants will be notified via email.

Scholarship eligibility varies by program, term, and campus. For complete eligibility requirements, scholarship descriptions, and details on the application process, visit www.UMabroad.umn.edu/scholarships.html. Students will be considered for all funds for which they are eligible based on the information provided. No more than one award per term (may be a combination of public or private funds) or two awards per year will be granted and will not exceed the maximum amount per term. Scholarship awards are term-specific and do not transfer to future terms if plans change. Scholarship application, information, and deadlines are subject to change. A signed University of Minnesota release and waiver and proof of CISI international insurance are required to release the awards.
